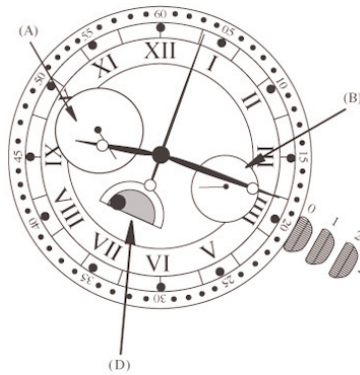


## WATCH DISPLAY



- A - DAY OF THE WEEK DIAL  
B - DATE DIAL  
C - CROWN  
D - MOON AGE DIAL

## TIMESETTING

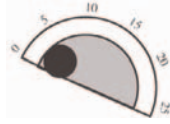
### Setting the age of the moon

1. The moon dial represents the age of the moon; the actual shape of the moon during each phase is not represented.
2. Use the moon dial only as a guide to the age or phase of the moon when reading and setting the watch.

- a) Setting the age of the moon with the age scale

\*Check on the age of the moon for the day by checking the newspaper or another source. If the moon's age for tomorrow is used, subtract one day before you make the setting.

\*Setting procedure (Example: age of the moon: 4.4) Pull the crown out to the first position.



Turn the age of the moon dial clockwise until the center of the moon is in line with the 4.4 on the scale.

- b) Setting the age of the moon without the age scale
- \*Check the newspaper or another source that lists the current age of the moon. Referring to diagram, set the moon dial to the age closest to that listed. More accurate settings can be made at the time of a new moon (0) or full moon (15)

### Setting the time/calendar

\*Please make sure you have correctly set the moon phase before you start to adjust time.

- a) Locate the crown on your Stauer watch (see diagram part C). Please note the three crown positions (0-1-2) in part C of above diagram.
- b) To set the time: Pull the crown out to position "2" (see diagram part C) which will allow you to position watch hands for proper

time selection. Rotate the crown clockwise until the desired time is.

\*Always rotate your hour and minute hands in a clockwise direction to set the time. If you rotate the hands in a counter clockwise direction, it may not always change the day correctly.

- c) To set the day dial (part A): Pull the crown out to the "2" position and rotate the crown clockwise for proper day selection.

- d) The day of the week can only be set by advancing the hour hand by 24 hours per day.

## TIMESETTING CONT.

### Setting the date

- a) Pull the crown out to the first position.
  - b) Turn the crown counter-clockwise to set the date.
- The date should not be adjusted between approximately 9pm and 12:30am.
- After setting the time/date/day of the week and moon phase, please push the crown back to its normal position before using (position "1" (one)).

- Please remember to wear your Stauer watch each day to ensure its lifelong accuracy and dependability for your timekeeping needs. By continually wearing your Stauer watch, you will be taking full advantage of its state of the art automatic winding feature which, allows the watch to function utilizing your simple body movement. It can, however, be reactivated simply by instilling motion by being worn. When not wearing the watch, resting the watch on its side (with crown facing towards the ceiling) will help to keep more accurate time.
