

## TIMESETTING, CONT.



date and a moon phase dial

1. Locate the crown (part B) on your Stauer watch. Please note the three crown positions (0-1-2) in the diagram.

This watch features four distinct

watch face display dials: day, month,

2. To Set the Time: Pull the crown (part B) out to position "2" and rotate clockwise (away from you) to move watch hands to proper time selection. Once time is set, push crown back into original "0" (zero) position.

3. To Set the Date Dial (part C): Pull the crown (part B) out to the "1" position and rotate the crown clockwise (away from you) for proper date selection.

4. To Set the Month Dial (part A): Pull the crown (part B) out to the "1" position

and rotate the crown counter clockwise (toward you) for proper month selection.

5. To Set the Day of the Week Dial (part E): The Day of the Week Dial (part E) is set automatically with the time. After you have advanced the time by a full 24 hours, the day of the week will automatically advance accordingly.

6. The 24-hour Sun/Moon Dial (part D): The 24-hour indication dial does not require any individual setting as it is in sync with the time. This dial differentiates the time between AM and PM. Take this into consideration when setting the time on your watch.
