# TIME SETTING

positions (0-1-2).

#### SETTING THE TIME

- Locate the crown on your Stauer watch (see diagram part C) and note the three crown
- 1. Pull the crown (part C) out to position "2" and rotate the crown clockwise until the desired time is set.
- 2. When finished setting the time, push the crown back to the "0" position. At this point the second hand (part E) will begin to move.

#### SETTING THE DATE

- 1. Pull the crown (part C) out to position "1" and rotate it counter-clockwise to the desired date (part B).
- 2. Once the correct date is set, push the crown (part C) back into "0" (zero) position.

NOTE: The date should not be adjusted between the hours of 9pm and 1am.

### USING THE CHRONOGRAPH

### TO SET THE CHRONOGRAPH This chronograph is able to measure and

display time up to a maximum of 59 minutes (part G) and 59 seconds (part H).

- 1. The chronograph can be started and stopped each time button "A" is pressed.
- 2. Chrono Reset Button (part D) resets the chronograph. Both the chronograph second hand (part H) and the chronograph minute hand (part G) will return to the zero position.
- 3. Press the Chrono Reset Button again to resume normal watch functions.

### **CHRONOGRAPH RESET**

Chronograph Reset (includes after replacing the battery) This procedure should be performed when the chronograph second hand does not return to zero position after the chronograph has been reset and after the battery has been replaced.

- **1.** Pull the crown (part C) out to position "2".
- 2. Press the Chrono Reset Button (part D) to set the Chronograph Second Hand (part F) to the zero position. The chronograph hand can be advanced rapidly by continuously pressing the Start/Stop Button (part D).
- 3. Once the Chronograph Second Hand (part F) has been set to the zero position, push the crown (part C) back into "0" (zero)

1. The battery is only replaced at a professional service center, and consumers are not allowed to replace the battery themselves.
